How do I get to the Nice stadium?

How do I get to the public car park (P5)?

- A shuttle will run from the car parks to the stadium,
- The service is free for ticket holders,
- Pick-up at the car parks,
- Drop-Off Avenue Pierre de Coubertin Baraques,
- The return car park is handled by shuttle (pick up point will be the same as the drop off location).

Are there any lockers?

• Left-luggage lockers are available at the forecourts entrances.

Will there be alcohol sold on site?

• Yes, a lcohol will be sold at the Nice stadium.

Is it possible to eat inside the stadium?

• There is a wide selection of snack bars inside and outside the stadium.

What methods of payment are available on site?

• Credit card or cash are accepted (very few cash points of sale)

Is there a FanZone?

• The city of Nice is setting up a <u>rugby village</u> which will open its doors on September 8 in the Jardin Albert 1er (downtown Nice), and the Théâtre de Verdure.

I am Pregnant. How do I get to my seat?

• It is important to use the lifts a vailable to a ccess the forecourt.









People with disabilities

I have a disability but I don't have the proper ticket for my situation.

What should I do?

Go to the ticket offices located on rue du Sapin, to explain your situation. The people at the ticket offices will suggest the appropriate solution.

I have my ticket but, due to an injury, I have to use crutches or a wheelchair.

What should I do?

We strongly a dvise you to contact the ticket office. The ticket office customer service team will be able to find a solution a dapted to your situation. You may be asked to bring a medical certificate justifying your situation.

I haven't got my ticket yet and I want to go to a match.

What do I need to do?

Go to the main ticket office (Rue Alain Mimoun). The box-office opens 2h30 before kick-off.



What about accessible toilets and stand seating?

The stadium is equipped with accessible toilets and also has 130 accessible seats (1.15m-wide).

Can I take a lift to access the forecourt?

The lifts at each stadium access (North, South-East, West) allow you to access the forecourt (for disabled people who do not have a parking spot at PO). Disabled people with access to PO can reach the forecourt via a dedicated lift.

Practical information

- Any exit is final,
- Spectators under the age of 16 have to be accompanied by an adult,
- It is a non-smoking stadium.
